- Unpublished Works.
- Language: Spanish or English
- Minimum, maximum length: 5,000-8,000 words (excluding references)
- Citation style: APA, 7th edition
- File format: Word document (.doc or .docx)

#### THE FIRST PAGE OF THE MANUSCRIPT MUST INCLUDE:

- · Article title in uppercase and lowercase and bold
- · Full name of the author, institutional affiliation
- · Abstract: maximum 200 words in a single paragraph
- Keywords: five terms describing the article's content, avoiding repetition of words in the title.
- · Spanish translation of the title, abstract, and keywords (or English, if the original is in Spanish)

### **FORMATTING GUIDELINES:**

- · Font: Times New Roman, 12 pt.
- · Line spacing: 1.5.
- Margins: 2.5 cm on all sides.
- No tabs, indentations, or consecutive spaces.
- · Titles: Times New Roman, 16 pt.
- · Subheadings: Times New Roman, 12 pt., bold.
- · Proper use of italics, bold, small caps, and uppercase according to APA rules.
- Avoid hyphenation at the end of lines.
- Include references at the end of the text and appendices or annexes if necessary.

# **PEER REVIEW PROCESS:**

- All submitted manuscripts will undergo a double-blind peer-review process. Accepted book chapters will be included in the volume, which is scheduled for publication in 2027.
