 undergraduate and graduate levels and lead instructional activities specified in the approved
 curriculum and in the faculty bylaws. These activities include lecturing, leading seminars,
 individual and group tutoring, writing and grading exams, grading papers and reports, and
 conducting and supervising evaluation activities.
- To coordinate designated academic activities in the Department of Health Sciences and for the Nursing Program.
- To participate in departmental and school activities, including meetings, committees, course and program evaluation, curriculum development, and grant preparation.
- To provide academic support and advice to students.
- To undertake cutting edge research activities to contribute to the intellectual mission of the University.
- To participate in calls for research proposals.
- To publish research achievements.
